Boulder Ballet is a 501(c)(3) non–profit organization.

Boulder Ballet believes that diversity of perspectives, ideas, life experience, talent, and culture enriches the artistry and practice of dance. We seek a candidate with a commitment to prioritizing these values within the organization.

Responsibilities

- Work with Artistic Director, School Directors and choreographers in the creation of costumes from design through production for the season's performances.
- Participate in the hiring, training, scheduling, and supervision of contracted costumers, wardrobe support and volunteers.
- Schedule shop volunteers and collaborate with production staff.
- Collaborate with contracted costume designers or other production staff to discuss and execute costume design details in new construction, major repairs, or alterations.
- Purchase, rent, or requisition costumes and other wardrobe necessities.
- Budget and manage costume shop expenses in collaboration with ED including materials and contract labor.
- Examine costume fit on cast members and sketch or write notes for alterations.

- Create a timeline for completion of all costumes to ensure they are ready for a preliminary dress rehearsal one week before the actual dress rehearsal.
- Check the appearance and fit of costumes on stage or under lights during dress rehearsals to determine whether desired effects are being achieved.
- Have costumes cleaned and pressed after performances and perform any minor repairs.
- Return borrowed or rented items when productions are complete and return other items to storage.

Requirements:

- Proven experience in designing/constructing a full range of costumes, specifically for ballet/dance.
- Supervisory experience including basic budgeting.
- Proven success in working with budgetary restrictions.
- The ability and patience to work with children.
- Must be available to work evenings and weekends, September through June.
- Must be available to be at all performances and subsequent rehearsals:

 - o DBG Fall Showcase
 - o Nutcracker Rehearsals/Performances (4) at Macky Aud., Boulder

 - o Winter Show, 5 performances at The Dairy Arts Center

 - BB2/Choreographer's Showcase (BBS) in The Dairy Arts Center
 - o Spring Show, 5 performances in The Dairy Arts Center
 - Recital (BBS), in The Dairy Arts Center
 - Ballet in the Park performances, Highlands Ranch and Boulder
 - Additional community engagement performances may be added to support outreach.
